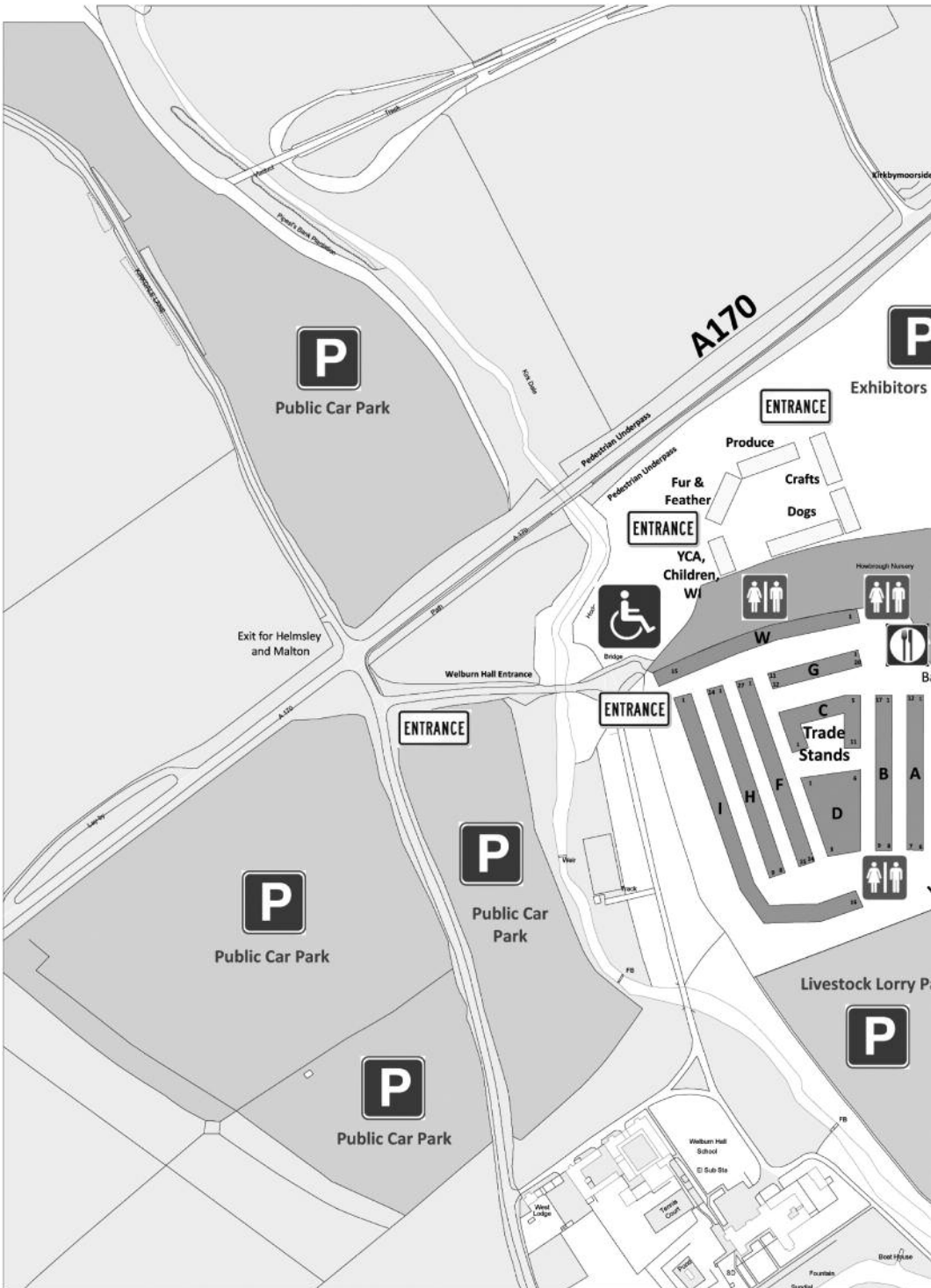

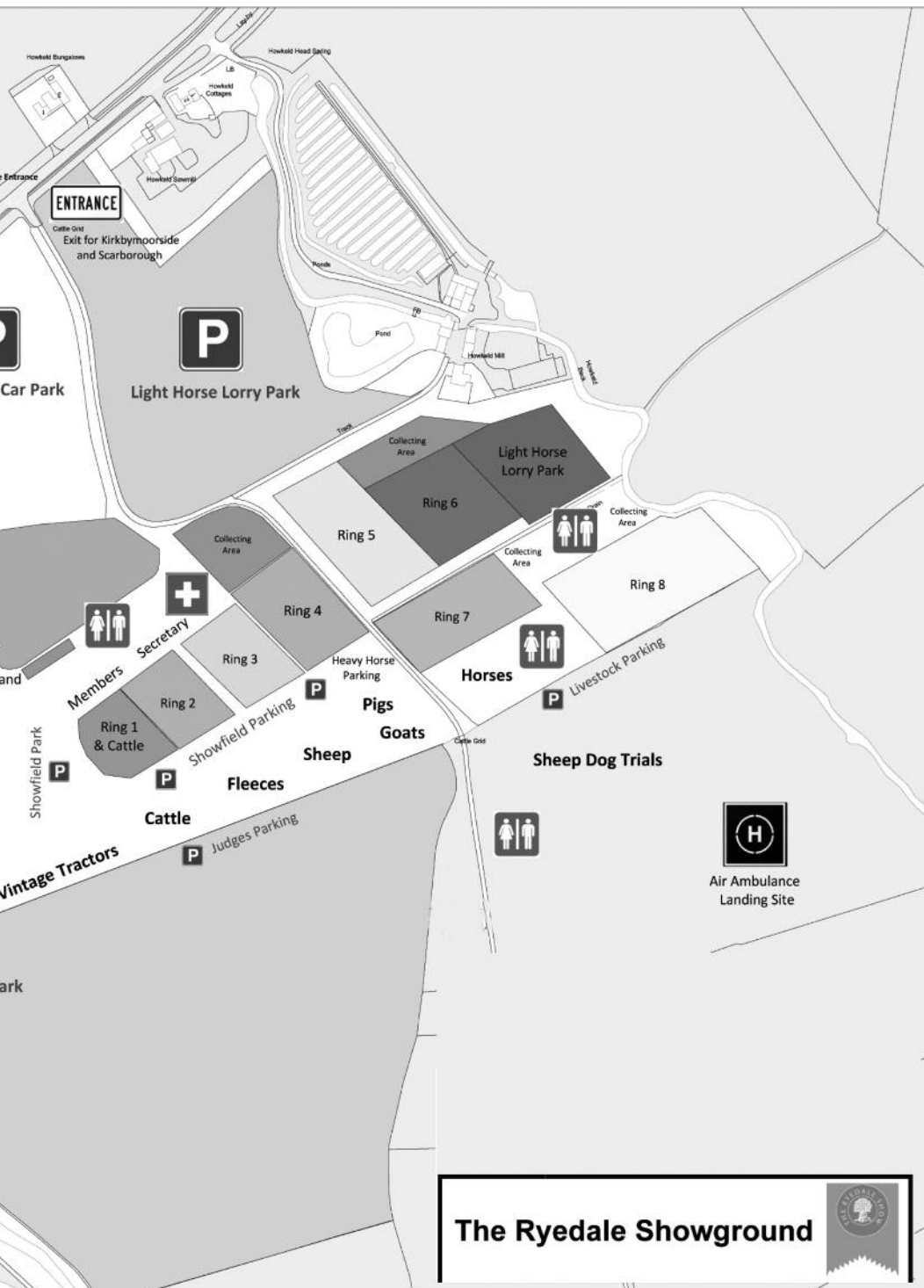

## **RULES OF THE SOCIETY**

1. The Object of the Society is to exhibit the products of Agriculture, Horticulture, Bee-Keeping, Poultry and Livestock breeding with a view to improving the standards of these products in Ryedale and Pickering Districts, to benefit farmers and advance the cause of Agriculture at an Annual Exhibition (Ryedale Show).
2. The Society will not conduct the Show for profit and any surplus monies accruing will be carried forward to improve and increase the scope and layout of the following and subsequent Shows which will be carried on with the objects set out in 1) above.
3. For the purposes of definition, the Show Area shall be the area that was administered by the Pickering Urban, Pickering Rural, Kirkbymoorside Rural and Helmsley Rural District Councils.
4. Ryedale Show and its Committee will not be responsible for any loss, damage or expenses incurred to any person, exhibit or property during the Show from whatever cause. Every exhibitor shall indemnify the Ryedale Show against all claims that arise through the presence on the Showground of himself, employees, stock or otherwise. All exhibits are at the sole risk of the exhibitor.
5. All persons in charge of stock, implements etc brought onto the Showground shall be subject to the orders, regulations and rules of the Committee or Officers appointed by them. Any disputes arising must be referred to the Show Committee, who will be authorised to remove persons refusing to conform to the rules from the Showground, as also their stock.
6. The Committee reserve the right to remove any objectionable or noisy competitors or unruly exhibitors, attendants or spectators.
7. Any exhibitor knowingly giving a false or incorrect certificate shall forfeit any prize money and be liable to be debarred from exhibiting at the Society's show in any future year.
8. All stock must have been bona-fide the property on the Exhibitor at the time of entry, unless otherwise provided. No stock will be allowed to compete in more than one class except where otherwise stated.
9. Entry forms which are not completed correctly will not be accepted.
10. Ryedale Show reserves the right to cancel, limit, divide or amalgamate any class.
11. Ryedale Show reserves the right to appoint a replacement judge whenever it is deemed necessary.
12. Ryedale Show reserves the right to refuse entry.
13. The decision of the Judge is final.
14. Objections to entries or awards must be made in writing to the Secretary and must be made on Show Day, accompanied by a deposit of £10 which will be refunded in the objection is sustained.
15. All disputes shall be referred to the Ryedale Show Committee whose decision is final.
16. No animal suffering from a contagious disease may be brought onto the Showground.
17. In the event of a Veterinary Surgeon advising the removal of any animal from the Show, his decision shall be final and immediately complied with.
18. All cups/trophies remain the property of the Ryedale Show and the acceptance of a cup/trophy by the holder is a guarantee that the cup/trophy will be returned to the Secretary, free of cost, ONE MONTH prior to the following Show.
19. Any exhibitor who does not produce an entrance ticket must pay the relevant admission.
20. Grand Parade – cattle to be paraded first and to be presented with cups with horses to follow. No livestock to be removed from the Showground before 4pm.
21. On the morning of the Show, the Showground will open to the Public at 8.30am. Tickets will be: Adults (over 16) £10, Children (5-16) £5, Children under 5 years Free, Family Tickets (2 adults and up to 3 children) £30.
22. No refunds will be given due to adverse weather conditions.
23. Safety – the safety of persons on the Showground is of major concern to the Society. Precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present have been taken. As the Show is held on an agricultural field, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. All persons must obey the instructions of the Society's stewards, officials and staff and comply with any published safety instructions.
24. By making an entry, the exhibitor gives consent to their personal data being retained and shared with relevant bodies in accordance to the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) May 2018. The Society shall not retain personal data for longer than necessary and will destroy records in accordance with the GDPR and Society policies.
25. By making an entry in any classes specifically for children, the parent of the child consents to personal data relating to child being shared with relevant bodies.
26. All dogs must be kept on leads and under proper control at all times.

- No animal may be shown in more than one Class unless otherwise stated.
- All cattle transport conveying these animals must enter the Showground, unload and load as directed.
- Entries for these Classes must state Registered Name, Herd Book Number and Date of Birth in respect of each animal, where applicable.
- For the purpose of this Show "A Heifer" is a female beast not having had its second Calf and a "Cow" is a beast having had two or more calves. If there are sufficient entries the Beef Heifer Class will be split by age at the Stewards discretion.
- Sealed Teats of Cattle. The Society prohibits the sealing of teats of cattle whilst at the Show and it is a recommendation to the judges that they should consider the withdrawal of any cow paraded with sealed teats.
- Should there be less than 6 entries in any Beef Cattle Section, then the Committee reserve the right to amalgamate those entries into the Any Other Beef Breed Section.
- Should there be sufficient entries in the Any Other Beef Breed Section then it will be split into Native and Continental.
